Teacher Made Assessments- used in the classrooms as a common formative assessment. Results answer these questions: How well is the student learning the material being currently taught? To what degree are the current strategies benefiting each student/ Does something have to be done differently in order to accelerate the student's progress? What specific feedback will benefit the student?

Assessment required for English Learners for federal Title III accountability. Used as exit criterion for state funding.

Teacher made assessments- Results answer these questions: How much did the student learn? Has the student obtained the standard? How effective was the instruction in this course/unit/grade level for each student? Should adjustments be made for next term?

Literacy Assessments

Locally determined adaptive assessment used for measuring proficiency (RIT Score aligned to content ready to learn) and growth (unique student projected targets by term)

Assessment developed and administered by the state. Required for federal and state accountability. Measure proficiency of academic standards.

## **Disseminating Results:**

- Formative and summative local assessment scores are shared with students and parents/guardians at the time of the assessment, Fall and Winter Conferences, and on the trimester Report Card.
- MAP scores are given to students at the end of the assessment. Student goals are set within their classroom. MAP Scores are shared with parents/guardians during Fall and Winter Conferences through the MAP trending report and/or NWEA website.
- Preliminary MCA scores will be sent home with students a week after testing has closed.
- Official MCA, MTAS, Adapted ACCESS & ACCESS scores will be mailed home in early September as ISRs are made available. Public summary results are also available on the MN Report Card found on the MDE website.
