After discussing that masking will be hard to enforce because it is not mandated at so many places the families will go and that families still have the choice to wear masks, and this was put up to a vote:

TCIS effective Monday 3/14 is lifting its mask mandate and will move to a voluntary choice masking policy with the caveat that 3% or more of the school body (staff and students) reaches COVID positive that the school would remask for a period of 10 days.

Mr. Cyprian motioned to approve making masking optional. The motion was seconded, and the motion carried.
